



## Lesson Policy

The following policy and rates apply to all students taking lessons with Equi-Librium. It is our goal to make your riding experience as positive and as fun as possible. Please help us by adhering to the following guidelines. If you have any questions or concerns do not hesitate to ask.

The following rates will be applicable as of January 01, 2007

Private Lesson	40
Group Lesson 2-5 riders	30
Children's ½ hour ride	25

1. All lessons are fifty minutes in length unless otherwise noted.
2. Please notify us in advance if you must cancel a scheduled lesson. Make-up lessons will only be offered if 24hours notice has been given. Make-up lessons will be scheduled at the instructor's convenience and must be taken within 30 days.
3. Make all checks payable to Equi-Librium.
4. Students are required to come to class in the appropriate dress. It is fundamental to the success of the rider to be dressed in a manner that promotes comfort and safety. Respect yourself as well as your instructor and fellow class members when choosing your attire.
5. Dress that is inappropriate or causes discomfort when riding distracts from the learning environment. The following is acceptable:  
**Boots:** These may be of any style but must have a smooth sole and at a minimum a ½ inch heel. If wearing paddock boots chaps (either full or ½) or Jodhpur straps must also be worn.  
**Approved helmet:** This will be provided for your initial lessons, however if you intend to continue in your riding career you should purchase your own. A helmet must be worn at all times when handling horses on the property. All individuals under 18 must wear helmets in lessons, **NO EXCEPTIONS.**  
**Breeches or jeans:** Jeans are appropriate if riding western or english, however if riding english, chaps (either full or ½) must also be worn.
